



NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

FOR THE HOUSING ASSETS TRANSFER LIST

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Oversight Board for the Successor Agency to the Fullerton Redevelopment Agency will hold a public meeting regarding the consideration and approval of the Successor Agency's Housing Assets Transfer List. Pursuant to Health and Safety Code ("H&SC") Section 34176(a)(1), on January 17, 2012, the City Council of the City of Fullerton ("City"), by Resolution No. 2012-07, determined that the City elects to, and shall, retain the housing assets (i.e., properties, loan receivables) and functions of the former Fullerton Redevelopment Agency. Pursuant to H&SC Section 34176(a)(2), the Successor Agency on July 31, 2012 submitted to the State of California-Department of Finance for their review and approval a list of all housing assets to be transferred to the City and contains an explanation of how the assets meet the housing asset criteria. On August 30, 2012, a Department of Finance letter stated it has no objections to any assets or transfers of assets to the City identified on the Housing Assets Transfer List.

The public meeting will be conducted by the Oversight Board at the Council Chamber, Fullerton City Hall, 303 W. Commonwealth Avenue, Fullerton, CA on Wednesday, May 22, 2013 at the hour of 3:00 p.m.

All interested persons are invited to attend said meeting and express opinions of the Housing Assets Transfer List. This public meeting is part of the dissolution process of the Fullerton Redevelopment Agency per Assembly Bills x1 26 and 1484 and all interested parties are encouraged to attend.
