George Fullerton Fullerton Part of the Amridge brothers plan was to offer George Fullerton, the President of the Pacific Land and Improvement Company and the right of way man for the railroad, just that - a right of way through their land. The plan worked, and the Santa Fe Railway Los Angeles to San Diego line was routed through this very spot in 1887. In appreciation, the town was soon named in his honor.
