Intake Release Center (IRC) Sheriffs Jail Booking Form (F0680-195)

California Penal Code 853.6 has been amended and the changes are effective January 1, 2019. The Orange County Sheriff's Department is expediting the printing of a new jail booking form that addresses the amendments to P.C. 853.6. The amendments to P.C. 853.6 expand the list of circumstances that permit an officer, who arrests a person for a misdemeanor, to not cite and release the person.

Until the new forms are available, the arresting officer must be aware of the four new check boxes they may write in the blank lines beneath the "SYNOPSIS: (For Officer's Use Only) section of the jail booking form. The corresponding reason should be written exactly as follows:

- The arresting officer has reason to believe that the person would not appear at the time and place specified in the notice
- Is subject to Penal Code Section 1270.1
- Has been cited, arrested or convicted for misdemeanor or felony theft from a store or a vehicle in the 6 months preceding the current arrest
- There is probable cause to believe that the person is guilty of committing organized retail theft as defined by Penal Code Section 490.4(a)

If applicable, these items must be written on the white page of the jail booking form and not the yellow copy that is kept by the arresting agency.
