

## NOTES:

- 1. CENTRAL WARM—AIR FURNACES INSTALLED IN AN ATTIC MUST BE ACCESSIBLE FOR ROUTINE INSPECTION AND MAINTENANCE BY THE OWNER/OCCUPANT AND FOR SERVICE AND REPAIR AS NEEDED. CHANGING FILTERS, LUBRICATING MOTOR AND FAN BEARINGS, CHECKING BELT TENSION, AND RELIGHTING THE PILOT FOLLOWING A SERVICE INTERRUPTION ARE NORMAL OWNER FUNCTIONS.
- ADEQUATE LIGHT, AN ELECTRICAL OUTLET, SAFE ACCESS WAY AND SUFFICIENT WORKING SPACE ON THE CONTROL SIDE ALL ENCOURAGE AND FACILITATE MAINTENANCE AND ALSO ENABLE RAPID EGRESS IN AN EMERGENCY.
- 3. ATTIC LIGHTING SHALL BE EITHER HIGH EFFICACY OR CONTROLLED BY MOTION SENSOR
- 4. ATTIC ACCESS MAY BE REDUCED TO 22"X30" FROM 30"X30" IF THE LARGEST PIECE OF EQUIPMENT CAN BE REMOVED THROUGH THE 22"X30" OPENING.
- 5. ALL ELECTRICAL WIRING SHALL BE PROTECTED WITHIN 6' OF THE ATTIC OPENING (7' IF ACCESS LADDER IS INSTALLED).
- 6. PROVIDE A MINIMUM 1" CLEARANCE WHERE VERTICAL VENT PENETRATES THROUGH ROOF DECK.
- 7. ATTIC SHALL PROVIDE AN ADEQUATE AMOUNT OF COMBUSTION AIR.
- 8. FURNACE SHALL HAVE A MINIMUM OF 30" OF WORKING PLATFORM IN FRONT OF THE UNIT AND A MINIMUM OF 30" OF VERTICAL HEADROOM.
- 9. HERS RATING INSPECTION IS REQUIRED FOR REFRIGERANT CHARGE, IF MORE THAN 40' OF DUCT IS CHANGE-OUT, THEN HERS RATING IS REQUIRED FOR DUCT LEAKAGE TEST.
