



# A MESSAGE FROM YOUR SENIOR CLUB PRESIDENT

Dear Members,

As my tenure as your President comes to a close, I want to take a moment to reflect on our actions and achievements during my past two years. Firstly, I want to express my gratitude for your continued support and engagement in the Fullerton Senior Club. Starting with the areas where time constraints became a challenge, we are still in the process of transferring our financial institutions, and there remains a possibility that this transition will be completed by the end of the year. Additionally, while we made strides in some committees, the full establishment of standup committees proved challenging with a volunteer membership.

On a positive note, we have made significant progress in transitioning from manual accounting practices to software-enabled accounting, which will greatly streamline the Treasurer's responsibilities in the future. We have also taken steps to digitize our important documents, ensuring their security with multiple backups and cloud-based accessibility.

In terms of productivity, we successfully launched a YouTube channel, providing an effective way to communicate with our members going forward. This platform will enable us to share important information, events, and activities more conveniently, enhancing our engagement with you.

Furthermore, I'm delighted to share that during my tenure, we helped drive the enabling of video security cameras in collaboration with the City Manager, the Police Force, and the Community Center to enhance the overall safety of our center. This initiative has allowed us to monitor the comings and goings of individuals during our activities, ensuring the safety of our members at all times.

Looking ahead, I encourage continued growth in our communication and networking efforts with the Fullerton Community Center, Meals on Wheels, Fullerton City Hall, and other vendors. Strengthening these relationships will enable our club to expand its resources and personal connections.

Finally, I am incredibly proud of our collective achievement in overcoming the challenges posed by the COVID-19 pandemic. Our membership, which had dropped to 400 members during the pandemic, has remarkably rebounded to nearly one thousand members in less than two years. This represents a membership improvement of nearly 150%, and it is the accomplishment I hold most dear during my time as your President. Please note that there will be no mailed January 2024 FSN Newsletter. This decision has been made to limit postage and publishing costs during a month that is traditionally slow with news due to holidays. Instead, we will provide an "in-house" printed January 2024 FSN sheet that will include all of the election results that can be picked up at our office or accessed online.

Thank you for your unwavering support, and I am confident that the Fullerton Senior Club will continue to thrive in the years ahead. It was an honor to be your President for the past two years.
