Subject: Fatal Traffic Collision

Date: March 14, 2024

On March 14, 2024, at approximately 1:08 AM, Fullerton Police Officers responded to the area of N. Gilbert St. and Castlewood Dr. regarding a traffic collision involving an overturned vehicle.

Upon arrival, Officers located a dark-colored Toyota Corolla that collided with a tree on the east side of Gilbert St, south of Castlewood Dr. The vehicle appeared to have been traveling southbound on Gilbert St. before it crossed the center median and collided with the tree. Fullerton Police Officers discovered a 23-year-old male driver, unconscious inside the vehicle. The Fullerton Fire Department arrived on scene and extricated the driver from the vehicle. Sadly, the driver was pronounced deceased. The identity of the driver will be released by the Orange County Coroner's Office.

At this time, Accident Investigators do not suspect there to be any other vehicles involved and it is unknown whether drugs or alcohol played a factor in the cause of the collision.

This is an on-going investigation, and the exact cause of the collision is still under investigation. Anyone with information about this collision is encouraged to contact Accident Investigator J.
